




1. Coin Design



Create a new coin design for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee.






2. Medal Design




Create a new medal design for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee.

Create a new Coat of Arms to celebrate 70 years on the throne for Queen Elizabeth II.






4. Cake Topper



Create a cake design for a cup cake to celebrate 70 years on the throne for Queen Elizabeth II.







5. Timeline



Create a timeline of key events witnessed by the Queen during her lifetime and 70-year reign.







6. Bunting



Create a bunting design to celebrate 70 years on the throne for Queen Elizabeth II.






7. Pecha Kucha



Pecha Kucha (Japanese for 'chit chat') is a live storytelling format, where the presenter has 20 slides with images and can only talk about each slide for 20 seconds. No more, no less. Sound easy?

Create a Pecha Kucha of key events witnessed by the Queen during her lifetime and 70-year reign.

- Do some research and make notes what is interesting? Unexpected?
- 2. Select 20 images to illustrate the key events.
- Using Adobe Premiere Rush, create a slide deck with the 20 images.
- 4. Add text to each slide / image but keep it brief!
- Practice presenting the Pecha Kucha, making sure that you only talk for 20 seconds for each slide
- 6. Use the voiceover feature to record your presentation.






8. News Bulletin




Create a news report about the forthcoming Platinum Jubilee.
