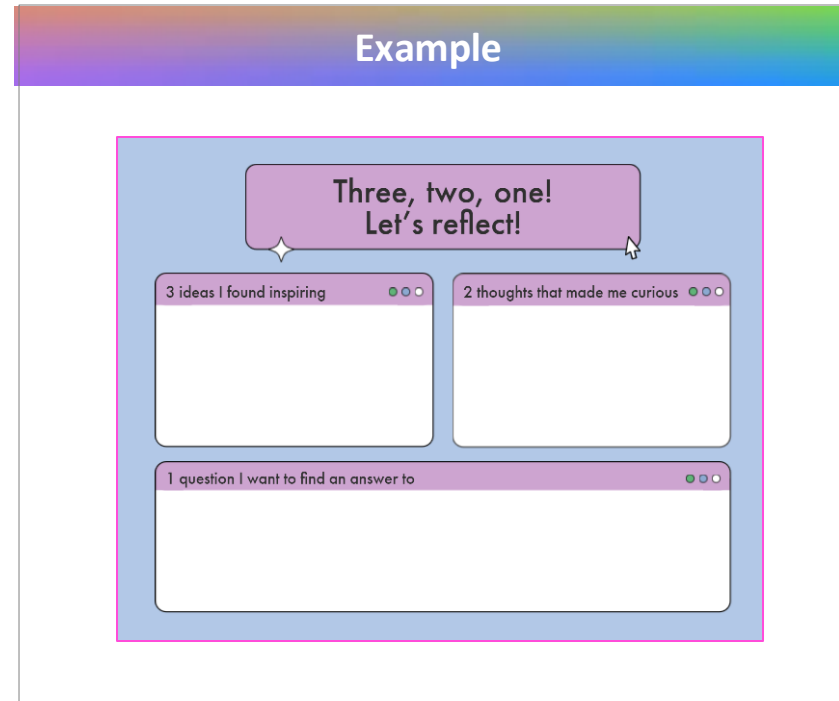
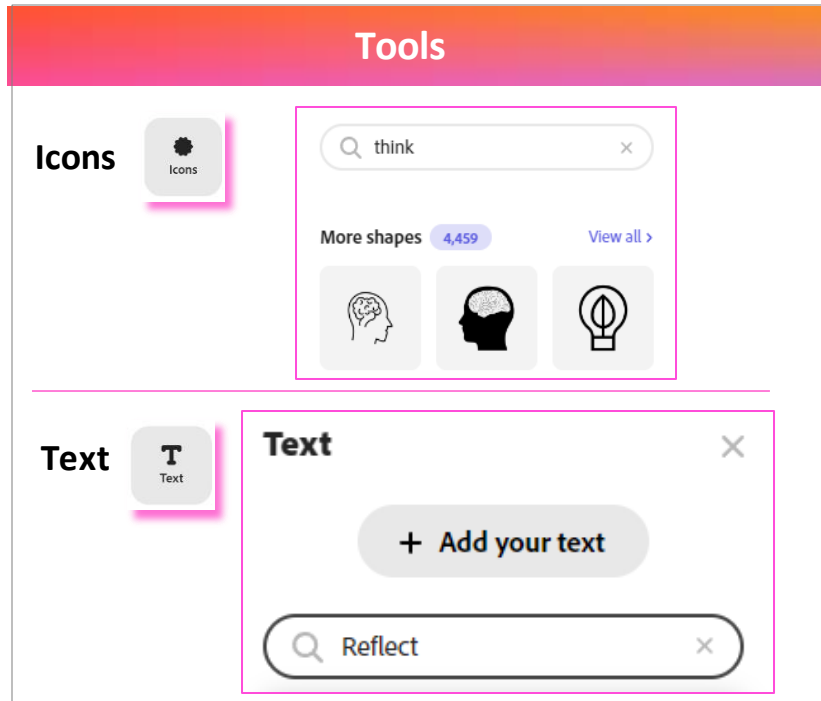
The following activities are ideas for creative lessons using Adobe Express. Each activity can be created as either a Graphic, Video or Website. The following are some example projects to get you started...

1. Graphic Design



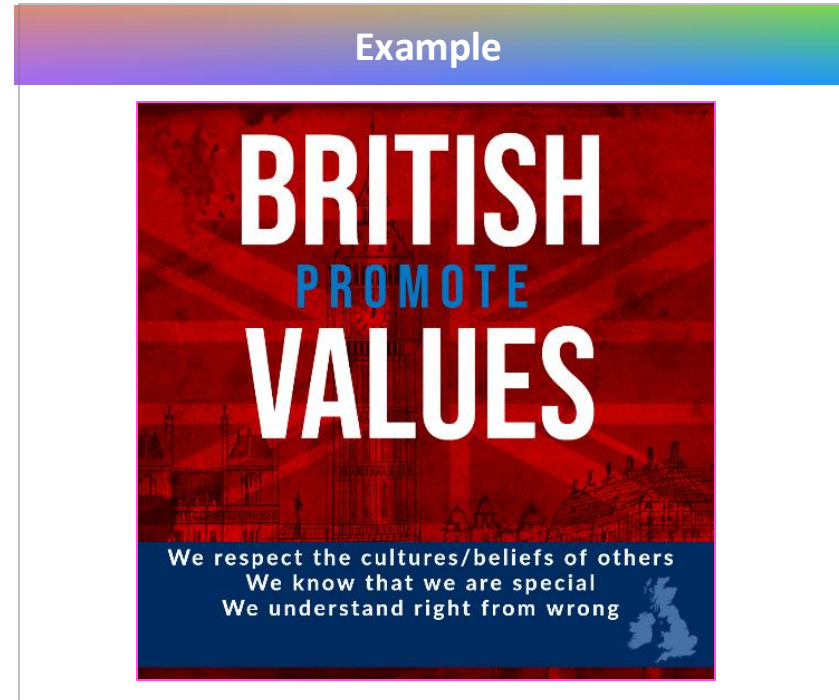
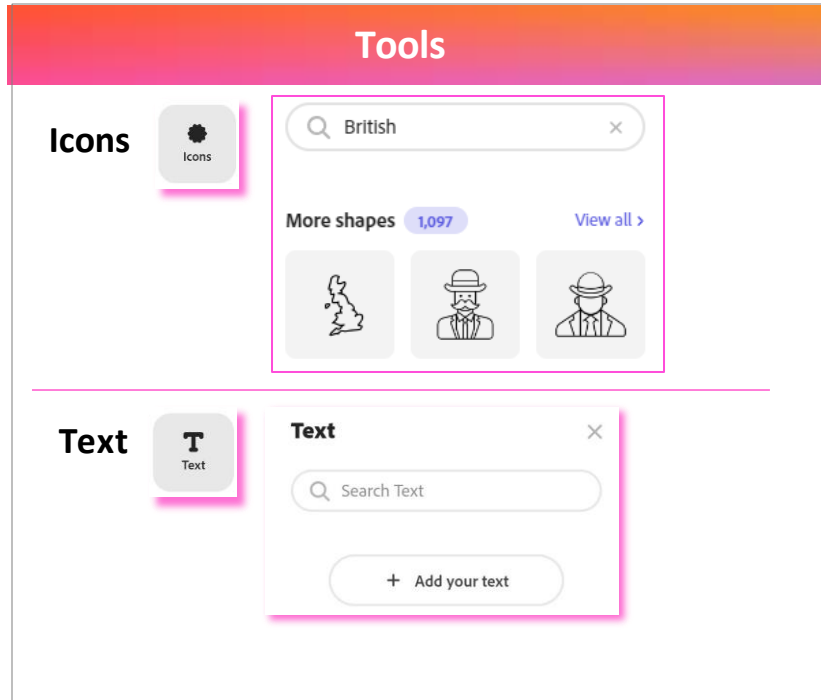

Things to think about:

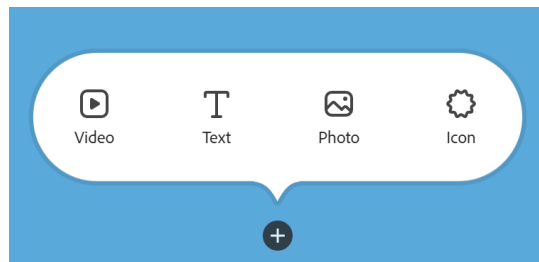
- What cultural influences have shaped your own heritage and those of others?

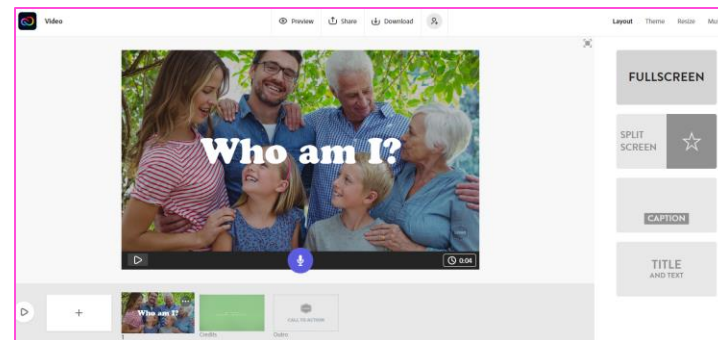
